IN RE: HB775 by Dutton (Relating to reports by certain juvenile court judges on children committed to Texas Youth Commission facilities.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Family Code by requiring the juvenile court judge in a county with a population of 600,000 or more to post on the county's Internet website a report containing certain statistical information about children committed by the judge to the Texas Youth Commission. The judge would be required to update the report on a quarterly basis.
