IN RE: HB835 by Dutton (Relating to the adoption and enforcement by the board of trustees of a school district of rules relating to student conduct.), **As Introduced**

The bill would prohibit a school board of trustees from adopting or enforcing a rule that would make a violation of the student code of conduct a Class C misdemeanor unless the violation would otherwise be an offense under state or federal law.
