IN RE: HB843 by Olivo (Relating to the discipline of public school students who voluntarily surrender prohibited items.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would authorize school districts to adopt guidelines under which a student could avoid disciplinary action by turning in a prohibited item that was unknowingly brought to school.
