**IN RE: HB919** by Eissler (Relating to coverage for certain mental disorders in children under a health coverage plan established by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas under the Texas School Employees Uniform Group Health Coverage Act.), **As Introduced**

<b>No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>
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The bill would require that diagnosis and treatment of Anorexia Nervosa and Bulimia in children younger than 19 years of age be covered as part of the TRS-ActiveCare health insurance plan for active public education employees. Since TRS-ActiveCare is self-funded, associated costs would be assumed to be recovered through increases to premiums of approximately \$4 to \$5 per year per covered employee.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
