The bill would increase the threshold amounts for construction contracts as those amounts relate to requirements certain water districts must follow in soliciting bids. The bill would also authorize the board of a district created by special law to contract for the construction and repair and renovation of district facilities and for the purchase of equipment, materials, machinery, and all things that constitute or would constitute the plant, works, facilities, or improvements of the district as long as no conflict existed with the district's special law.
