IN RE: HB1111 by Turner (Relating to prohibiting medical, psychiatric, and other research on children committed to the Texas Youth Commission.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends Human Resources Code, Section 61.076 by restricting the Texas Youth Commission (TYC) from allowing a youth committed to TYC facilities from participation in medical, psychiatric, or other types of research programs.
