**IN RE: HB1115** by Howard, Charlie (Relating to prohibiting immunization against human papilloma virus as a condition for admission to public school.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would prohibit requiring immunization against human papilloma virus (HPV) as a condition for admission to any elementary or secondary school. All contrary executive orders of the governor would be preempted by the bill.
