**IN RE: HB1139** by Guillen (Relating to the resumption of employment by a retiree within the Texas Municipal Retirement System.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would revise the requirements under which a retiree participating in the Texas Municipal Retirement System could return to municipal employment and resume membership without suspension of the person's annuity.

**Local Government Impact**

Based on information provided by the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS), there would be no significant fiscal impact to the TMRS member municipalities.
