**IN RE: HB1166** by Gallego (Relating to the authority of certain counties to develop a parks and recreation system under the law governing sports and community venue projects.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code by authorizing a county that has a population of less than 2,000 and that contains no incorporated territory of a municipality to provide for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, or renovation of a county parks and recreation system as a venue project under Chapter 334.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
