IN RE: HB1203 by Talton (Relating to the prosecution of the offense of interference with child custody.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code by amending conditions related to the prosecution of the offense of interference with child custody. It is assumed that the bill would not significantly affect the operations of state or local government.
