IN RE: HB1213 by Pitts (Relating to mutual assistance agreements entered into by certain municipalities and private institutions of higher education for the purpose of enforcing state law and to additional powers, privileges, and immunities of peace officers employed by private institutions of higher education.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The provisions of the bill to authorize a municipality and a private institution of higher education to enter into a mutual assistance agreement regarding peace officer services would apply only to the cities of Dallas, Houston, and San Antonio.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
