**IN RE: HB1250** by Howard, Charlie (Relating to prohibiting discrimination based on a student's secondary school in awarding certain financial aid for higher education.), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would allow graduates of unaccredited high schools (including home school programs) to compete for loans through the B-On-Time Student Loan Program. Provisions of the bill would be absorbed within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
