**IN RE: HB1254** by Bonnen (Relating to environmental permitting fees and electronic reporting.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would allow the Commission on Environmental Quality to adjust fees as necessary to encourage electronic reporting and the use of the commission's electronic document receiving system. Although the bill could result in slight changes to fee rates, the fiscal implications are not expected to be significant.
