IN RE: HB1380 by McCall (Relating to court security and the use of money in courthouse security and municipal court building security funds.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill specifies how courthouse security funds may be used. In addition, under the provisions of the bill, a local administrative judge would be required to provide to the Office of Court Administration a written report regarding any security incident involving court security that occurs in or around a building that houses a court for which the judge serves as local administrative judge.
