**IN RE: HB1457** by McReynolds (Relating to the acceptable methods for disposal of poultry carcasses. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would eliminate as an acceptable option for poultry carcass disposal the cooking of poultry carcasses for swine food. There could be minimal costs to the Commission on Environmental Quality relating to changes to rules and publications.
