**IN RE: HB1472** by Miller (Relating to the annexation of land for which property taxes are imposed based on the land's value for agricultural or wildlife management purposes.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Chapter 43, Local Government Code, to authorize a municipality to annex an area qualified for agricultural or wildlife management use. A municipality would not be allowed to annex an area unless the municipality offers to make a development agreement with the landowner as specified in the bill.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
