**IN RE: HB1541** by Isett, Carl (Relating to preannouncement of certain promotional events and purchases by certain alcoholic beverage permit holders.), **As Engrossed** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends Alcoholic Beverage Code, Section 102, which states a permittee may preannounce a promotion to a consumer. This bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission anticipates no significant fiscal impact on the department from the implementation of this bill.
