### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require school districts to report to the Commissioner of Education on certain non-violent behavioral offenses committed by students in grades Kindergarten through 5.

## **Local Government Impact**

School districts may be required to modify software for reporting purposes. The average statewide cost for adding data elements to reporting software is \$5,000 per element.
