**IN RE: HB1648** by Leibowitz (Relating to allowing a county to hold a nonbinding referendum on a county fiscal matter.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize a county commissioners court to hold a nonbinding referendum on any question affecting a county fiscal matter other than a matter involving a labor agreement or compensation of any county employee. The county would be required to hold the referendum in the same manner as an election on a county measure on a uniform election date.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
