IN RE: HB1679 by Hughes (Relating to the General Land Office's determination as to the existence of vacant public school land.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would allow those filing vacancy applications with the General Land Office to include field notes describing the land and the lines and corners surveyed and a plat depicting the results of a survey.
