IN RE: HB1739 by Hartnett (Relating to electronic submission of certain information on a death certificate.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill relates to electronic submission of certain information on a death certificate. The bill would modify Section 193, Health and Safety Code, to require the person in charge of interment and the person completing medical certification on a death record to submit the information electronically as specified by the state registrar.

The bill would take effect on September 1, 2007.
