**IN RE: HB1866** by Zerwas (Relating to the establishment of a tow truck rotation list in certain counties; providing a penalty.), **As Introduced**

The bill would apply to a county with a population of 300,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a population of 2.3 million or more. Based on the 2000 U.S. Census, the bill would apply only to Fort Bend County.

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
