**IN RE: HB2030** by Giddings (Relating to the issuance of citations to certain students on school property during regular school hours.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would prohibit a peace officer from requiring a student under age 12 to sign a citation issued on school property during regular school hours. If the student's parent or guardian were unable to be present when a citation was issued to the student, a school administrator or teacher would be required sign the citation to acknowledge that it had been issued, and a school official would be required to notify the student's parent or legal guardian within two days that the citation had been issued.

**Local Government Impact**

School districts would be required to update policies and procedures in accordance with the provisions of the bill.
