**IN RE: HB2045** by Phillips (Relating to revenue from Texas State Rifle Association specialty license plates.), **As Engrossed**

<b>No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to change the distribution of revenue from the Texas State Rifle Association specialty license plate that is appropriated to Texas A&M University and specify that the proceeds are to be appropriated to the Texas Cooperative Extension of Texas A&M University. Fifty percent of the amount appropriated to Texas A&M University would be used to supplement existing and future scholarship programs supported by the Texas State Rifle Association and the remaining fifty percent would be used to support the 4-H Shooting Sports Program for youth.

Based on the analysis of the Texas A&M University System Administrative and General Offices and the Texas Department of Transportation, it is assumed the provisions of the bill would not result in a fiscal impact to the state.

The bill would take effect on September 1, 2007.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
