**IN RE: HB2090** by Hill (Relating to the creation of a local government transportation corporation by a hospital district or hospital authority.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to add "hospital district or hospital authority" to the definition of "local government" for the purpose of forming a local government transportation corporation.

**Local Government Impact**

The fiscal impact would depend on whether a hospital district or authority were to choose to form a local government transportation corporation and the activities of that corporation. Chapter 431, Transportation Code, authorizes various means of funding related to operations of a corporation.
