IN RE: HB2231 by Corte, Frank (Relating to the authority of the Railroad Commission of Texas to file a lien on certain land adversely affected by past mining practices and reclaimed by the commission.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would remove the condition that property be held since May 2, 1977 as a requirement for property being protected from having a lien filed against it for mining-related reclamation activities for persons who did not consent to, participate in, or excercise control over an affected mining operation.
