**IN RE: HB2414** by Isett, Carl (Relating to hunting from public roads or rights-of-way. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

<b>No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>
---

The bill would amend the Parks and Wildlife Code relating to hunting from public roads or rights-of-way. The bill would forbid hunting from public roads or rights-of-way, as described, including a public street, alley, road, right-of-way, berm, ditch or shoulder, except for the trapping of a raptor for educational or sporting purposes. To the extent the bill would amend descriptions of public roads or rights-of-way, no significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated..

The bill would take immediate effect if the bill receives two-thirds the vote of all members; otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
