IN RE: HB2466 by Geren (Relating to promotional activities engaged in by a local distributor of alcoholic beverages.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would add Section 23.07 to the Alcoholic Beverage Code to prohibit an alcoholic beverage distributor from entering the premises of a mixed beverage permit holder or a private club for the purpose of determining the brand of alcoholic beverages sold and to promote the sale of other brands. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2007.

The Alcoholic Beverage Commission anticipates no significant fiscal impact to the agency.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
