IN RE: HB2468 by Solomons (Relating to the filing of financial statements by justices of the peace and candidates for justice of the peace in certain counties.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to add the office of justice of the peace to those offices required to file a financial statement with the county clerk, and to reflect that addition with regard to requirements of the county clerk's office in maintaining those records. The bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
