IN RE: HB3396 by Gallego (Relating to granting certain counties general zoning authority around certain military facilities; providing a penalty.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would add Subchapter L to Chapter 231 of the Local Government Code regarding zoning around Laughlin Airforce Base, and would apply only to the unincorporated area of Val Verde County.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
