IN RE: HB3476 by Gallego (Relating to the construction of communication facility structures in certain counties.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 240.082(a), Local Government Code, to add that the subchapter would apply to a county that is located adjacent to an international border and which contains a federal military installation and a national recreation area. Under current statute, the subchapter applies only to a county with a population of 1.4 million or more. The new criteria would add Val Verde County to the counties to which the subchapter would apply.

The bill would take effect immediately if it were to receive the required two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2007.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
