**IN RE: HB3682** by Anderson (Relating to deferred disposition of certain traffic offenses by certain holders of out-of-state driver's licenses. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to add the spouse or dependent child of a member of the United States military forces serving on active duty to the list of persons to whom the court would be authorized to require to successfully complete a driving safety course for dismissal of certain traffic offenses. The bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
