**IN RE: HB3861** by Orr (Relating to the bidding requirements for emergency service districts.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to increase from \$25,000 to \$50,000 the minimum expenditure for certain items or services that would require an emergency service district board to submit to competitive bids.
