IN RE: HB3872 by Menendez (Relating to the eligibility of certain applications to receive allocations under the low income housing tax credit program.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to modify the eligibility of certain applications to receive allocations under the low income housing tax credit program.

Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs, it is assumed that costs related to the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be covered by utilizing existing resources.

This bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

Local Government Impact
