**IN RE: HJR6** by Straus (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail to a person who violates certain court orders or conditions of release in a felony or family violence case.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated,** other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$77,468.

The resolution, if approved by the voters, would authorize denial of bail to a person who violates certain court orders or conditions of release in a felony or family violence case. The proposed constitutional amendment would be required to be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
