## No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would direct trial courts to give preference in setting hearings and trials for ad valorem tax matters in appeals brought under §42.01 or 42.015 of the Tax Code for counties with a population of less than 675,000. The bill would take effect September 1, 2007.
