**IN RE: SB63** by Zaffirini (Relating to the powers of the commissioners court of certain counties that have no incorporated municipality.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize additional powers to the commissioners court of a county with a population of more than 5,000 that is located within 100 miles of an international boundary and that contains no incorporated territory of a municipality. Current statute authorizes those additional powers to the commissioners court of a county with a population of more than 7,500 that is located on an international boundary and that contains no incorporated territory of a municipality. The change in criteria would add counties to those to whom Section 81.033, Local Government Code would apply.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
