**IN RE: SB66** by Zaffirini (Relating to the construction of cattle guards on county roads. ), **As Passed**  
**2nd House**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize all counties to construct cattle guards on a county road of any class. Under current statute, only counties with a population of less than 60,000 have this authority.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated should a county chose to construct cattle guards.
