IN RE: SB66 by Zaffirini (Relating to the construction of cattle guards on county roads.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would authorize all counties to construct cattle guards on a county road of any class. Under current statute, only counties with a population of less than 60,000 have this authority.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated should a county chose to construct cattle guards.
