IN RE: SB141 by Nelson (Relating to a feasibility study regarding joint health science courses at a public or private institution of higher education.), **Committee Report 2nd House, As Amended**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Under the provisions of the bill the Higher Education Coordinating Board, in consultation with members of the Health Professions Council and with representatives of private or independent institutions of higher education, may conduct a feasibility study regarding joint health science courses at public or private institutions of higher education. The costs associated with the study will be absorbed within existing resources of the agency.
