IN RE: SB199 by Nelson (Relating to certain convictions barring employment at certain facilities serving the elderly or persons with disabilities.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

The bill would amend Section 250.006 (a), Health and Safety Code by adding certain criminal offenses to those listed in subsection (a), conviction of which makes an individual permanently ineligible for employment in facilities covered in Chapter 250.
