**IN RE: SB254** by Ellis (Relating to the sale of live animals in certain counties on a public highway or road, the right-of-way of a public highway or road, or a parking lot.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code by changing the population limits for determining which counties by order may regulate roadside vendors and solicitors. The change from applying to a county with a population of more than 2.2 million to a population of more than 1.3 million would add Bexar and Tarrant Counties.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
