IN RE: SB311 by Van de Putte (Relating to reemployment rights of certain members of the National Guard.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code by requiring private employers to retain members of the Texas state military forces and state military forces of any other state who are ordered to authorized duty. The Adjutant General's Department has determined that the cost of implementing the bill would not be significant.

Local Government Impact
