**IN RE: SB336** by Brimer (Relating to the notice required for the lease of real property by certain counties when responding to particular emergency circumstances.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Section 263.007(e), Local Government Code, to authorize certain counties to lease certain real property for 95 days or less to provide short-term emergency disaster relief services without having to post its intent to lease the property 30 days prior to establishing the lease.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
