**IN RE: SB395** by Harris (Relating to dismissal of the charge in certain traffic offense cases.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to increase from \$10 to \$20 the amount of an administrative fee for dismissing the charge of driving with an expired inspection certificate, expired driver's license, or expired registration.
