IN RE: SB443 by Hinojosa (Relating to the authority of a school district board of trustees to create a criminal offense for violation of a district policy.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.

The bill would repeal the criminal penalty in the form of a Class C misdemeanor currently associated with violations of school district policies adopted under the authority of Subchapter D, Chapter 37, Education Code relating to the protection of buildings and grounds.
