**IN RE: SB469** by Brimer (Relating to the creation by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board of a certificate of recognition for persons who contribute certain gifts or donations to public institutions of higher education.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

Under provisions of the bill, the Higher Education Coordinating Board will design and produce a certificate of recognition for persons who contribute donations in excess of \$10,000 to public institutions of higher education. The Higher Education Coordinating Board will implement provisions of this bill within current resources.
