IN RE: SB688 by Shapleigh (Relating to the area served by certain municipal drainage utility systems.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code by adjusting the population criteria and adding geographic criteria for determining which municipalities would be authorized to extend a drainage utility system service area outside of its municipal boundaries. Based on the criteria, the bill would apply only to the City of El Paso.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
