IN RE: SB688 by Shapleigh (Relating to the area served by certain municipal drainage utility systems.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code by changing the population criteria for determining which municipalities would be authorized to extend a drainage utility system service area outside of its municipal boundaries.
