IN RE: SB717 by Ellis (Relating to the selection by certain governmental entities of providers of landscape architectural services.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend Section 2254.004 of the Government Code to add landscape architects to the list of professional service providers that a governmental entity shall choose on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications.
